- **ELFI - Electronic Research Funding Information**

[ELFI](#) is a service center for electronic research funding information in German-speaking countries. A database provides information on research funding and allows for targeted, personalized use. In this database, you will find comprehensive information on ways to obtain funding. From funding programs to financing of material and travel costs, prizes, and scholarships, all conceivable funding opportunities are included. Users receive extensive information on funding institutions and their programs. The original call for proposals texts, information sheets, and forms can be downloaded directly. In addition to a short summary, addresses, contact persons, deadlines, and funding amounts are also provided for each funding opportunity.
