The Medical Faculty of the Westfälische Wilhelms-Universität Münster offers the position of a

University Professor (Full Professor; W3) for Regulatory Mechanisms of Inflammation

at the Center for Molecular Biology of Inflammation (ZMBE), which comprises five institutes (Cell Biology, Infectiology, Medical Biochemistry, Molecular Biology and Molecular Virology) and associated junior research groups. The ZMBE is a joint institution of the Faculties of Medicine, Chemistry/Pharmacy and Biology.

The future holder of the position must fully represent the subject with regard to research and teaching and should have an internationally recognized research profile in the field of regulatory mechanisms of inflammation. She/he is expected to establish an independent research program, to closely interact with the existing research groups at the ZMBE (<http://zmb.uni-muenster.de>) and to cooperate with research programs of the university, in particular the Interdisciplinary Clinical Research Center (IZKF), the Collaborative Research Centers (Sonderforschungsbereiche, SFB), the Max Planck-Institute of Molecular Biomedicine and the cluster of excellence 'Cells in Motion' (EXC 1003). The successful candidate will be the director of the previous Institute for Experimental Pathology, which will be renamed in due time.

Prerequisite for the application are scientific achievements as a Junior Professor, from a postdoctoral lecture qualification (habilitation), as a research scientist at a school of higher education/university, non-university institute, industry, administration, or other fields of society within or outside Germany.

The University of Münster is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to increasing the proportion of senior women academics. Consequently, we actively encourage applications by women. Female candidates with equivalent qualifications and academic achievements will be preferentially considered within the framework of the legal possibilities. We also welcome applications from candidates with severe disabilities. Disabled candidates with equivalent qualifications will be preferentially considered.
